You may be worried about the safety of someone who is “vulnerable”.

A person is “vulnerable” if they need care and support due to an illness, disability or mental illness.



You might be worried that



they are being hurt physically or emotionally.



someone might be spending their money.



they are not looking after themselves.



they might be neglected by the people that care for them at home or in a care home.



We call this raising a “safeguarding concern.”



You should contact the local council.
